

Embark upon a journey through time to discover the unique fate of a Cistercian abbey nestling at the bottom of a small valley that has become home to a fabulous art collection!

The church and its chapterhouse were built in the 13th century. The abbey's living quarters now house part of the rich collection of modern art dating from the 1940s to the 1970s and featuring the work of iconic artists such as Dubuffet, Michaux and Hantaï, bequeathed with the abbey by Geneviève Bonnefoi and Pierre Brache. The garden, meanwhile, is a great place to relax and enjoy a stroll.

DID YOU KNOW...?

The abbey was converted into a farm during the French Revolution, until it was bought back in 1960.
